About the Speech: "Sri Jagannath: A Visual Configuration" on December 15, 2023 Dr. Sk. Makbul Islam explored the origins and evolution of Lord Jagannath's concept across India, highlighting diverse architectures, images, and structures. The four main characters - Jagannath, Balram, Subhadra, and Sudarshan Chakra - were showcased, revealing regional variations. It was an excellent experience for all the participant irrespective of religion to observe the intense research and interpretation done by him.
